

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-007**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE OFFICIAL NAME OF THE CITY PARK LOCATED ADJACENT TO THE CITY LIBRARY AS “LIBRARY PARK,” AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Deer Park (“City”) owns and operates a City park adjacent to a Spokane County Regional Library building located at 208 S. Forest Street in the City (“Library”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City staff have been unable to locate any records to indicate that the park adjacent to the Library has even been given an official name by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council received a letter from representatives of the Library requesting that the City park adjacent to the Library be formally designated as “Library Park;” and

**WHEREAS**, the Library representatives advised that Library staff and volunteers have made significant efforts to clean and maintain the park (including removal of downed trees), and that designating the park as “Library Park” would be an appropriate way to honor their contribution to the park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council desire to recognize and honor the contributions Library staff and volunteers have made to the City park adjacent to the library and the positive impact these contributions have had on the City and the local Library by officially identifying the park adjacent the Library; now therefore,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City park located adjacent to the Library is hereby declared to be and is named “Library Park.”

**Section 2.** The Library is hereby authorized to post a trail head map at the A Street and Forest Avenue entrances to Library Park in locations approved by City staff.


**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage by the City Council.
