JUB has found several inconsistencies in these numbers. JUB will be researching the operations to justify the airports existing classification prior to moving forward with a new classification.

**Issue: Cedar Road Infrastructure and Construction**

The board was updated on the Cedar Rd. construction project.

Stan Roth reported on the teleconference held with the FAA concerning approval to operate UAS aircraft in the vicinity of the airport. Stan reported that the FAA and AMA were very receptive and complimented the Baron's on their safety procedures.
