




The Deer Park City Council is the legislative body in local government — setting the policies, approving spending and making the decisions that shape our community.

Here's what they do:

-  Pass Laws and Policies – The Council adopts ordinances, resolutions, and regulations to guide Deer Park's future.

-  Approve Budgets – They review and approve how the City spends public funds.

-  Authorize Contracts and Spending – The Mayor can only sign contracts or make major financial commitments with Council approval.

-  Represent the Community – Councilmembers listen to residents and work to reflect the community's needs and priorities.

And this fall, four City Council seats will be on the ballot!

If you're interested in running for City Council, the candidate filing window is May 5–9 through the Spokane County Elections office.
