

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-005

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE WATER QUALITY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY AND THE CITY OF DEER PARK FOR A LOAN TO FACILITATE THE NEW LAGOON AND PUMP STATION CONSTRUCTION AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Staff have reviewed the Water Quality Combined Financial Assistance Agreement No. WQC-2022-DeePar-00071 between the State of Washington Department of Ecology (“Ecology”) and the City of Deer Park (“City”) which provides funding for the City Sewer Lagoon and Pump Station Construction Project in the amount of \$6,698,000 (the “Ecology Loan Agreement”) and determined that the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement are beneficial to the City and recommend approval of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Ecology Loan Agreement is on file with the City Clerk-Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ecology requirements, the City held a public hearing on the Ecology Loan Agreement on March 16, 2022 at a regular open public meeting of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, following the public hearing, the Mayor and City Council find that passage of this Resolution is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City; **NOW THEREFORE**


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Ecology Loan Agreement is hereby approved by the City and the Mayor is authorized to execute the same on behalf of the City.

Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
