

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-007

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, WASHINGTON, REPEALING CITY RESOLUTION 2020-006; REPEALING THE CITY DECLARATION OF COVID-19 EMERGENCY; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, the City Council passed City Resolution 2020-006 declaring a state of emergency within the City with respect to the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") consistent with declarations of public emergency issued January 13, 2020 by the United States Department of Public Health and Human Services and February 19, 2020 by the Washington State Governor; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Timothy Verzal and City staff recommend repeal of Resolution No. 2020-006 and termination of the delegated emergency powers to the Mayor which powers have not yet been exercised and are deemed no longer necessary; and


WHEREAS, while COVID-19 has not disappeared within our community, the City Council finds that a public health state of emergency with respect to COVID-19 no longer exists; **NOW THEREFORE**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEER PARK, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. City Resolution No. 2020-006 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
