





In Deer Park's "strong mayor" form of government, the Mayor serves as the City's chief executive officer, overseeing the daily operations and administration of city government. In Deer Park, the Mayor is a part-time position.

Here's what the Mayor does:

-  Implement city laws and policies adopted by the City Council
-  Prepares and proposes the annual city budget
-  Provides high-level leadership to city staff
-  Represents the City at official functions and events

While the Mayor guides the staff in the operations of the city, all code changes, major contracts and financial decisions must be authorized by the City Council — keeping a strong balance between leadership and accountability.

If you're interested in running for Mayor, the candidate filing window is May 5–9 through the Spokane County Elections office.
